PLAYER DEVELOPMENT
REFUND POLICY

North Dakota Amateur Hockey Association (NDAHA) Player Development (PD) will use the following guidelines for refunds associated with all registration fees collected for their youth boys and girls fall leagues.

Refunds will be processed only for the following reasons:

- . Injury - \$25 Processing Fee
- . Sickness/Illness - \$25 Processing Fee
- . Moving out of area - \$25 Processing Fee
- . Not filling teams' roster due to lack of participation - \$0 Processing Fee

To receive a refund for any injury, sickness/illness and moving out of the area a written email must be sent to Ryan Griggs; rgriggs@ndaha.org which contains a detailed explanation for the request. In the event of an injury, sickness/illness NDAHA may request a note from a doctor on letterhead indicating that the player cannot participate.

Should the injury, sickness/illness or the moving out of the area occur before league practices and games have started a \$25 processing fee will be charged to the refund. Should the injury, sickness/illness or the moving out of the area occur after league practices and games have started a \$25 processing fee will be charged to the refund and the refund will be prorated and will be determined by the PD Committee.

Should the player have in their possession any clothing and/or equipment that is the property of NDAHA, it is the responsibility of the player and players family to set up return of said property, which may include shipping costs to return the items. Said refund will not be issued until everything has been returned to Ryan Griggs.
